

Golf COVID-19 Update – January 6, 2021

Thank you for your interest in golf at Wintergreen Resort. Due to the continuing efforts of the resort to keep you safe while playing the Stoney Creek course, the following guidelines have been put in place:

- Face Coverings (covering the nose and mouth) are required at all times when on-site. This **includes indoors and outdoors** and are required from when you depart your vehicle in the parking lot until you tee off. **This includes the practice range.**
- Tee times are currently available daily from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm. The golf shop at Stoney Creek is open daily from 9:30 am – 3:00 pm.
- We ask that carts are returned back to the clubhouse area by 5:00 pm.
- Carts may contain 2 persons but course personnel will still permit single riding in carts for those that are uncomfortable sharing a golf cart.
- Walking is permissible by the course professional and walking fees are listed on the golf shop counter.
- Stoney Creek will continue to not have rakes on the course so if you are in a bunker, it is advised to lift, clean and place the ball in an area of the bunker void of footprints and proceed with your shot.
- Flagsticks at the Stoney Creek course are configured with a secondary cup and foam insert to prevent the ball from falling to the bottom of the cup. Please continue to leave the flagsticks in the hole during play.
- Please continue to abide by the social distancing rules set in place at 6 feet and please continue to not gather in the golf shop or on course property before or after your round.
- The Stoney Creek shop does have limited snacks and beverages that can be purchased in the shop.

Thank you for continuing to adhere to the safety guidelines set in place by the Resort and staying safe while playing golf at Stoney Creek.
