- Golf Pro Shop reopens Saturday, May 2
- An assortment of snacks and drinks (non-alcoholic & beer) will be available
- Social distancing is expected with no gathering before or after rounds

- Court preparation will begin Monday, May 4 with an anticipated opening of May 11
- Court rentals are available for members and their guests (by reservation only-424.325.8235)
- Racquet restringing services are available

- Court preparation will begin shortly after Stoney Creek courts are operating
- Anticipated opening day of Memorial Day Weekend

- Private lessons & small clinics will be available (by reservation only-434.325.8235)
- Tennis Pro Shop reopens as well. This is a small space, social distancing is expected.
