RED, WHITE & BLUE 9-HOLE DETAILS

Eligibility:

4 person teams consisting of current Wintergreen members and/or Guests with a current USGA Handicap. The team 9-hole handicap has been derived from taking 25% of Player A, 20% of Player B, 15% of Player C, and 10% of Player D. Handicap indexes will be used as playing handicaps for this event. The team handicap will be subtracted upon the completion of play. Tournament committee will use all handicap indexes as of July 3rd.

Format:

All teams will be competing in a Captain's Choice format at Stoney Creek Golf Course with tees of play varying on each hole.

Prizes:

Prizes awarded for top teams in each flight gross and net, along with an overall gross winner.

Flights:

Men's Flight (*May consist of 4 men or 3 men and 1 woman*)
Mixed Flight (*May consist of 2 men and two women or 1 man and three women*)
Women's Flight (*Must consist of 4 women*)

Tees of Play:

Men: 59 and Under – *Red, White, and Blue Tees*
Men: 60-79 – *Red, Gold, and White Tees*
Men: 80 and Older – *Green, Red, and Gold Tees*
Women: 59 and Under – *Green, Red, and Gold Tees*
Women: 60 and Older – *Black Tees, Green, and Red Tees*

Tie Breaker:

In the event of a tie, a scorecard playoff will be used to determine the winner. An acceptable method of matching cards is to determine the winner on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes. If the tying players have the same score for the last nine, determine the winner on the basis of the last six holes, last three holes and finally the 18th hole.
